

Proper preparation and packing are essential to ensure a smooth trip with your Peritoneal Dialysis (PD) system. This is an example of a packing list that you may use to prepare for your trip. Please consult with your care team to verify your individual needs. You may not need everything on this list. Your packing list will depend on your access, prescription, destinations,* and itinerary.



Treatment Supplies

Solution bags (for cycler or manual treatment as needed)

Drain bags/drain lines

Caps

Disinfectant (as trained)

Masks

Thermometer

Blood pressure cuff

Bathroom scale (if one is not available at the destination)

PD fluid warmer



For cycler patients only:

Cycler sets

Liberty® travel case

Exit Site Supplies

Small/large gauze

Exit site cleanser (as trained)

Under pads

Paper tape

Island bandages

Water proof patches (if used)

Masks

Exit site cream (if needed)

Optional Ancillaries

Medications (as prescribed)

Medical supplies (as required

by your clinic)

Shower necklace

PD belts

Gloves
